

Gate City Planning Commission

October 5, 2010

The regular monthly meeting of the Gate City Planning Commission was held on October 5, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. Members present were: David Flanary, Rita Tipton, JoAnn Castle, Delaney Herron and Faye Sanders. Also present was Michelle Jenkins, Town Attorney. Town Manager Steve Templeton was returning from an out-of- town meeting.

The Chairman determined there was a quorum for the meeting.

The meeting was brought to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chairman David Flanary.

There was no public expression.

There was a motion by Delaney Herron, seconded by JoAnn Castle, to approve the September 7, 2010 meeting minutes with a correction of the word "home" in the second line of the first paragraph of the minutes.

Mr. David Flanary attended the September council meeting requesting a possible solution regarding a citizen of the town shooting a firearm from just outside the city limits into the town limits. David stated he had talked to Steve and he was planning to attend the Scott County Planning Commission meeting to explore possibilities of an ordinance.

New Business

There was further discussion regarding the terms of service that each Planning Commission member has. Some months ago this was brought up and the Town Clerk was to be notified this was a responsibility of this town position. These terms were to be staggered terms. David stated he would talk to the office staff the next day to find out about the term records.

There was discussion as to who would replace Rita Tipton as the Council Representative for the council. Rita is planning to move to Colorado. Michelle stated the council could appoint someone for a term only until the next regular election which is next May or holdover until the next November election.

Michelle recommended the Commission appoint someone to act as secretary for the next meeting in case the Council does not have the position replaced at that time. JoAnn Castle stated she would take the minutes temporarily.

Michelle explained that the theatre building in town was closed on by the Town of Gate City this week.

Rita explained to the Commission that the Town of Gate City is now listed on the National Historic Register as of September 9, 2010. East and West Jackson Streets are now considered a National Historic District. A map of the historic district was supplied to the Commission members.

There was a motion by Delaney Herron, seconded by Faye Sanders to adjourn the meeting.
