A) **ZONING ADMINISTRATOR**:

In the absence of Greg Jones, Roger Cassell presented the concept drawings prepared by Mattern and Craig Engineering for re-striping of parking spaces on downtown Jackson Street. From these drawings, it appears that the angle of the parking slots will be changed to project the parked vehicles further into the travel lane than they are now. It is the consensus of Planning Commission members that <u>increasing</u> the angle of the parking spaces will improve passage around longer vehicles parked on Jackson Street.

B) TOWN COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVE MEMBER:

Roger Cassell reported that the Scott County Sherriff's Office, which will be moving into the former County
Office Building on the lower level of the Lonesome Pine Regional Library, has requested a second entrance, from
Water Street, into the parking area serving the office. Currently, the parking area is surrounding by fencing limiting
access and egress to only one space off Library Avenue.

C.) GATE CITY TOWN ATTORNEY:

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- (1) Roger Cassell has found information that picnic tables for Gateway Park can be purchased from Virginia Correctional Enterprises for approximately one half of the previously expected cost. The cost, under \$500.00 each, would include shipping.
 - Mr. Cassell also stated that there is power available to the site which provides the option of installing one or more dusk to dawn lights. Jo Ann Castle recommended that interior lighting be provided to the information kiosk for interested visitors to inspect travel brochures in the kiosk. It is her hope that the solar light can be used.
- (2) The land use committee will meet at the proposed dog park to begin site planning when Mr. Jones is available.
