• \$20,000.00 Down Payment for CAT Backhoe

- Chairman, Roger Cassell stated funds were being put into the capital fund to pay for a new backhoe in the future. However, the backhoe that is currently being used is twenty years old and is having several mechanical issues that will be more costly to repair (\$18,000) considering depreciation, than to put a down payment on a new one. The current backhoe will have a trade-in value of \$20,000. Trade-in value changed the price of the new backhoe from approximately \$118,000 to approximately \$98,000.
